We are very pleased have Chris Panting from the Great Southern judging on Sunday. Chris has broad base knowledge, is an accredited Coach and breeder. Chris will be judging halter and ridden on Sunday. Our harness judge is yet to be finalised. The harness is being judge at 3PM on Saturday 25. The Western Ridden will be judged after lunch on Sunday by Di Bawden.

Hi Point allocation at the SOS Show-off will be the same as the State Championships. Point allocation will now reflect the number entered except for less than 3 entered where by first will still get 3 points and second 2. 1 entered first 3 points.

At this years State Championships numbers were allocated to competitors for the first time. These numbers should have been returned at the end of the show or posted to the secretary. The numbers correspond to your membership number and when more than one horse is entered will have a -1 -2 etc. after the membership number. About 20 numbers have not been returned, so a \$5 deposit will need to be made which will be refunded on the return of the number at the completion of the show. **Don't forget to pick up your numbers before competition starts.**

Understanding the term: **“Golden Buckskin”**

WABA first discovered the term and reference to “Golden Buckskin” in 2000, in a book published in 1999 called “HORSE COLOUR EXPLAINED”. Written by Jeanette Gower, a renowned horse breeder from the Mt Barker region of South Australia. Jeanette took 2 years to compile the book which was considered the best of its time.

“Golden Buckskin” was clearly explained as a Buckskin that appeared Bay with lighter than black coloured legs and a orange tinted body coat.

We have used the term and reference since, but have only registered 5, as they are very hard to distinguish. All the horses registered have a direct connection to Palomino.

The last one registered which foaled in 2010, is a QH filly who tested positive for the cream gene (pictured below). She is out of palomino by a brown. She has 2 copies of Agouti, one which of course had to be inherited from her Palomino dam and one copy of black from her sire.

The term “Golden Buckskin” is confusing: firstly they would better be described as ‘Bay Buckskin’ but the genetic colour code can currently not distinguish between ‘Cream to Typical to Golden Buckskin’ who are all technically speaking “Bay Buckskin”. Also some members consider there buckskins who look similar to the ‘Golden Palomino’, to be ‘Golden Buckskin’, but that coat colour we consider more Typical Buckskin.

Hopefully we will be able to distinguish between these colours as more is learnt about different combinations in the genetic colour code.

Black Buckskin ???? NOT AT ALL

Animal Genetics' test results surprise all, except our Registrar Jenny Brett: Recent result received for presumed "Black Buckskin" Abbalee Woodsman" test positive for Agouti.

This means his hair colour genetics test reads the same as any buckskin as far as Animal Genetics' are able to test.

He will now have to be presumed a 'Brown Buckskin' and will be tested for the 'At, agouti', to determine if he carries the 'Brown' variance of Agouti. (this test is done in a different lab)

We now know to determine the difference between Black and Brown Buckskin when the colour is so dark will require a test for Agouti as well as Cream and we will not be able to presume colour just by appearance.
